Do absolute truth, justice, and morality exist? Yes. We need God's counter-cultural reminder of personal responsibility and accountability: We are owed nothing. We are expected to contribute to a just economy in this world. We will be accountable ultimately to God's eternal economy.

DEFINITIONS

- "There is no absolute truth" is a statement assuming an absolute truth
- "You shouldn't judge someone else's moral choices" is a statement assuming that one is morally obligated not to judge
- Moral Argument for the Existence of God
 - If God doesn't exist, then objective moral values don't exist
 - Objective moral values DO exist
 - Therefore, God exists
